Directions: You will select a book to read and complete the activities below. Fill in the amount of pages you read per day using the book tracker. Your goal is to complete enough activities to earn 100 points.

<p>Create a Dictionary Pick 15 words from the book that you are unfamiliar with - write down their definitions and use them in a sentence.</p> <p>10pts</p>	<p>Design a new cover for the book. Must be completed in color.</p> <p>20 pts</p>	<p>Choose a character and imagine what he/she had to pack a suitcase for a trip. What would you find in it and why?</p> <p>20pts</p>	<p>Create a chart with symbols that represent a person from the text. Give the meaning of each symbol.</p> <p>20pts</p>	<p>Poetry Create a poem related to your book. The MUST contain at least one simile, one metaphor, one personification, and one hyperbole.</p> <p>30pts</p>	<p>Graph it . Develop a graph related to the percentage of book pages read per day. Use the data collected on your book tracker.</p> <p>30pts</p>
<p>Write a text/quiz for the book. Include 15 questions and create an answer key.</p> <p>10pts</p>	<p>Write a summary of the book or chapter you read. <i>2 paragraphs minimum</i></p> <p>20pts</p>	<p>Create a text message conversation between two characters from your book. Pick 1 event.</p> <p>20pts</p>	<p>Retell a major event from the story from a different character's point of view. <i>2-3 paragraphs</i></p> <p>30pts</p>	<p>Pick a scene that is described in detail in the story. Visualize the scene and draw a picture with your own description. Include details the author did not include.</p> <p>30pts</p>	<p>Make a hypothesis about what may have changed if a character were in a different setting in the book. <i>3 paragraphs</i></p> <p>50 pts</p>
<p>Write an interview for a main character of the book. Ask at least 5 questions and write the answer to the questions as the character would respond.</p> <p>10pts</p>	<p>Use a flow chart to explain several key events from the text.</p> <p>20pts</p>	<p>Choose a character and imagine you walked into his/her room. What would you find in the room and why? <i>2 paragraphs</i></p> <p>20pts</p>	<p>Summarize 3 events from the text by creating a colored comic strip.</p> <p>30pts</p>	<p>Write a letter to the author of the book that describes your opinion of the book .Include examples from the text as evidence. <i>3 paragraphs</i></p> <p>30pts</p>	<p>Make a prediction of a characters life in the future. Think about: Where will he/she live? What kind of job or career will he/she have? Will he/she still be friends with the same friends as before?</p> <p>50pts</p>
<p>Explain how nature played a role in events from the text. <i>1 paragraph</i></p> <p>10 pts</p>	<p>Compare and contrast two characters from the text using a Venn Diagram.</p> <p>20pts</p>	<p>Create a visual image of the main character. Then describe the character using 5 adjectives. Include an explanation for each.</p> <p>20pts</p>	<p>Make connections across stories. Compare and contrast this story to another one you have read.</p> <p>30pts</p>	<p>What questions do you have? Create 5 questions you would ask the author related to the book. These should be questions NOT already answered by reading the book.</p> <p>30pts</p>	<p>Write a sequel to the book. <i>Minimum 5 chapters</i></p> <p>100pts</p>
